Moved by Mr. Dean, seconded by Mr. Macaulay, that Seth Gordon of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, be employed to make a complete statewide survey of the present facilities for the production, management, and maintenance of wild-life in California, and the development of a recommended expansion program for fish and game as contemplated by the Wildlife Conservation Act of 1947.
