Subject: Texas Hill Reservoir Site

Rhinegold Creek. Flows over some bedrock, but gravel fairly abundant. Stream averages 3-6 ft wide with pools up to 1 ft. deep. Water very clear. Flow estimated to be $1\frac{1}{2}$ c.f.s. and 49° at noon. Old diversion dam (abandoned) below Big Cut Road bridge. Small may fly nymphs abundant. Lower stream brushy. Open grass land above reservoir site. Patches of gravel. Stream may be intermittent in summer. Saw two 8" trout. Scattered homes along banks. Land private and fenced.
