## PERMIT TO PLANT FISH IN WATERS OVERLYING PRIVATELY OWNED LANDS

I hereby certify that I am the owner of the lands underlying and surrounding the reservoir, pond, or lake described hereinbelow and located near Georgetown, County of El Dorado, State of California.  
(town or city)

Permission is hereby granted to the Department of Fish and Game of the State of California, its agents and employees, to plant trout in said (kind of fish) reservoir, pond or lake at such times and in such numbers as the said Department determines. In consideration of any one such planting I agree to allow the general public to fish in said reservoir, pond, or lake without fee or charge during the open fishing seasons and I further agree to permit the general public access to said waters by and through the road from County Road No. 63 (describe course of public access)

Such public fishing may be done from the shores or from a boat or from any wharf, pier, or jetty or landing extending into said reservoir, pond or lake.

With the consent of the Department or any one of its agents or employees I reserve the right to refuse or revoke permission to fish to any person who commits or threatens to commit any malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance.

This permit shall remain in effect for five years from date unless terminated by mutual consent of the undersigned and the said Department of Fish and Game.

I release the State of California, its Department of Fish and Game, and agents and employees, from all claim and demand for damages arising out of this permit or resulting from or through the use thereof.

This permit is not intended to create a lien upon the property herein described below but shall be binding upon my heirs and assigns for the said period of five years unless sooner terminated as hereinabove provided.

Description of property: In the County of El Dorado, State of California, that portion of the SE 1/4 of Lot 3, Section 5, Township 12 North, Range 11 East, M.D.B. & M., containing 3 acres, more or less, and known as Walton Lake.
