We have investigated Walton Lake in response to your request that we plant it with catchable fish.

The lake was planted regularly from 1956 through 1963 with catchable trout. It was dropped from the program in 1964 because of its small size and generally turbid water. It was consequent poor ranking in comparison with other larger more attractive waters in the area, such as Stumpy Meadows Lake.

Thank you for your concern in the fishery management plans for El Dorado County.
