## Applications 1692 - 2270 - 6138 Permits 1053 - 2631 - 3711

Your letter of November 20th.

The El Borado Irrigation District has the above numbered approved applications before this office for service of the area within its boundaries.

Application 1692 - Permit 1053 provides for the appropriation of 4000 acre feet per annum storage from Webber Creek to be collected from about October 15 to about May 15 of each season.

Application 2270 - Permit 2631 provides for the appropriation of 6000 acre feet per an um from North Fork of Cosummes River from about November 15 to about June 15; 15,000 acre feet per annum from Camp Creek from about November 15 to about June 15 and 7,000 acre feet per annum from Sly Park Creek from about November 15 to about June 1 to be stored in the proposed Mazel Valley Reservoir or Webber Creek reservoir. It also provides for an appropriation of 70 cubic feet per second direct diversion from about April 15 to about June 15 from Camp Creek and 30 cubic feet per second from about April 15 to about June 15 from Sly Park Creek.

Application 6136 - Permit 3711 provides for an appropriation of 3000 acre feet per annum from South Webber Creek from about November 1 to about April 30 and 2000 acre feet per annum from the North Fork of Webber Creek from about December 1 to about April 30 for storage in the Webber Creek Reservoir.

The projects under Application 1692, Permit 1053 and Application 6138, Permit 3711 were inspected on September 7, 1936 and action is pending the report of the inspecting engineer.

We are enclosing a 1939 progress report form to be filled in and returned to this office in connection with Application 2270, Permit 2631.
