Gentlemen:

This office is now prepared to issue a license on Application 1692, Permit 1053, providing for storage in Webber Creek reservoir and desires to set forth the following terms and conditions which will appear in the license if issued.

It was found by the engineer who inspected the project on September 7, 1939, that 1125 acre feet had been stored between October 15 and May 15 and put to beneficial use. If no word is received to the contrary within 15 days from date it will be assumed that license under these conditions is satisfactory.

It was also determined by the engineer, and this fact was confirmed by Mr. Maule and Mr. Jenkinson at the time of their visit to this office on January 7, that no use of water has been made from the North and South Forks of Webber Creek, nor is any use contemplated under Application 6138, Permit 3711. It was accordingly suggested to you under date of January 24 that you request withdrawal of Permit 3711 for the reason that the storage proposed under this filing was to be made in the Webber Creek reservoir and we understand that the District has been denied the right to increase the height of the Webber Creek dam under existing plans. It is therefore again suggested that you forward this withdrawal request at your early convenience.

In order that we may have up-to-date information relative to the boundaries of the District we are forwarding under separate cover a copy of the latest map submitted by the District and it is requested that you indicate thereon the present boundaries of the El Dorado Irrigation District. If the map is not large enough to show the existing boundaries a new tracing and 3 prints should be submitted showing the present boundaries of the District, the streams from which appropriations will be made under Applications 1692 and 2270, the ditch systems which will be used and any other pertinent information.

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The maps should conform to the general requirements of the print which is being forwarded to you. It is also requested that you show on the maps not only the existing ditches provided under the present filings before this office, but also the Diamond Ridge ditch system, for the reason that a part of this latter system has been advanced as diligence under Application 2270 and corresponding permit. When these data and maps have been received steps will be taken toward issuance of the license.
