

# Memorandum

Subject: Texas Hill Reservoir Site

Big Cut Road crosses bottom of reservoir. Terrain consists of rolling oak and ponderosa pine covered hills with considerable grass and pasture land.

Weber Creek in reservoir site has a gentle gradient with abundant areas of gravel and cobble bottom. Recent floods have scoured silt out leaving clean bottom. Pools average 15-20 ft. wide and 3-5 ft. deep. Cover consisting of logs, roots, willow thickets and undercut banks abundant. Stream banks very brushy with dense blackberry brambles making travel difficult. Valley quail numerous in area. Land private and posted. Stream flow estimated to be 15 c.f.s. Water visibility about 3 ft. and water temperature at noon 49° F. No fish observed.
