Dear Mr. Booth:

The dam to which you refer on Webber Creek in El Dorado County is not being proposed by the Department of Fish and Game. The project (Texas Hill Dam and Reservoir) is under study by the U. S. Bureau of Reclamation and is still only in the reconnaissance stage. Since the project has not been authorized by Congress, there are no funds available for construction.

The dam site is located in the east one-half of Section 19, T 10 N, R 10 E. The tentative high water line of the reservoir would be located at elevation 1831 feet above sea level and the reservoir would inundate 2.5 miles of Webber Creek.

In several months the Bureau of Reclamation will release its preliminary report on the Texas Hill project. The report should contain some of the information and maps that you are seeking.
