Subject: Winifred Lake, El Dorado County

Concerned angler phoned in on October 9, 1979 and reported he hiked into subject seven surface acre lake at elevation 6850, six miles from the Loon Lake parking area on October 8, 1979. He counted 75 dead 8-14 inch brook trout on the bottom of the lake. Water was clear with no signs of pollution. He concluded all fish in the lake were dead and had been so for about 3 days.

This lake is managed with brook fingerlings. Five hundred stocked in July 1979.

1,200 will be allocated for 1980.
