SUBJECT: Planting of Wrights Lake - EL DORADO Co.

As you can see from the enclosed copy of a letter to Harold Roberts, we will have 10,000 Brown Trout at Tahoe Hatchery on July 31, 1956, These fish, and the 5,000 Eastern Brook, will be available for planting in Wrights Lake any time after that date. Will you please arrange a date with the Wrights Lake Home Owners Association for planting the lake. Any date acceptable to them will be satisfactory to me, as will the time of arrival at the lake. When you inform me as to the date and time, will you also please inform me as to your desires in the manner of planting these fish, specifically as to where they should be planted. Will they all go directly into the lake, or will some of them be planted in the inlet stream?

1. Mark at least 50% of BN - if possible 75% or 100% - a mark by cutting both ventrals.
2. If time permits mark either 50% or 100% of EB. LV + Adipose.
3. Approximately 4 or 5 days before planting time (after fish have been marked) send somebody to Wrights L. to take shore & inlet temperatures. Notify Fraser or Pallott by phone. We will decide planting date & notify Wrights L. people.
