Dear Emory:

Thank you very much for the fishing record and the fish scales.

The brown and eastern brook trout for planting in Wrights Lake are now on hand at our Tahoe Hatchery, and we are in the process of marking the fish at the hatchery, feeling that this will be much better than marking them after they arrive at Wrights Lake. We were able to do this because we were not as pressed for time at the hatchery as we had originally anticipated (this doesn't happen very often).

We plan to send personnel to Wrights Lake in the near future to take temperatures and determine the best localities for planting. We will try to have them contact you if you are still at the lake. Our primary concern about the time of planting involves the temperatures of the lake water. If the temperatures are too high it may be advisable for us to wait until later in the season when temperatures begin to drop.

In any event we will work this out and make every effort to contact you or other members of the Wrights Lake Association prior to planting.
