Wrights and Park Lake, El Dorado County

On 8/2/67 I met with Phil Baker and others of Wrights Lake cabin owners association. I suggested the following plan for 1968:

1. Increase RTC program at Dark Lake.
2. Plant RTK 1/oz and some BN,-M-C in Wrights Lake.
3. Set 5 fish limit at Dark Lake and 2 fish limit at Wrights.

At this time we should plan for an allotment of about 12,000 RTC at Dark (1000/week - June 15 - Aug 29) and about 2,500 RTK 1/oz and 2,000 BN-M-C at Wrights.

The USFS reports 81 camp units (+30 more to be built) and 76 cabins in this area.

The use on Wrights is about 55 percent campers and 45 percent cabin. The ratio will change more in favor to the campers in the future as the cabins are started. On weekends up to 1,500 in the three big campgrounds around Wrights Lake.

Wrights Lake has a real potential to grow some interesting trophy and sport fish. Dark Lake is an ideal RTC water.
