

Repairs of Schmidell and Highland Lake Dams

Terence Potter talked with engineers of the Division of Supervision of Dams regarding the repairs that they feel are necessary on subject dams. The extent of the work is indefinite at this time and cannot be determined until the dams are inspected by us early this summer while they are still full of water.

The necessary repairs will probably be minor and should not cost over a few hundred dollars. We plan to repair them this fall, after the water level has gone down sufficiently through normal releases.

The Division of Supervision of Dams has asked that we notify them when we go in to make the repairs so that they can send a man with us; therefore, we should get their approval of the safety of the dams this fall.
