
Subject: Highland Lake, El Dorado County

One mono gill net was set overnight for 16 hours on August 27-28, 1984 and caught the following RT in prime condition:

8.5	9.5
9.0	11.0
9.0	11.0
9.0	11.5
9.3	11.5
9.5	11.5
	12.0

Two anglers reported catching, hooking and seeing large RT but only landed four in the 11-13 inch range.

The allotment was reduced from 3,000 to 2,000 RT-f in 1977. It is recommended that it be reduced again to 1,000 RT-f in 1985 and planted annually. It was not planted in 1982 because of ice on the lake at the time of air planting. Use on the lake appears to be light.
