TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Under the provisions of the Fish and Game Code of California, permission is hereby granted PARLEY GRASSIE, P.O. Box 91, Lakesport, California, to seine in East Park Reservoir, ^{Calusa} Glenn County, and Stony Gorge, Glenn County, for CARP under the following terms and conditions:

1. The permittee shall operate at all times under the direct supervision of a representative of the California Division of Fish and Game.
2. All costs of such seining shall be borne by the permittee, who is authorized to hold, and transfer such fish for marketing. All game fish, and all rough fish other than carp shall be returned to the water in good condition, and unharmed.
3. All men engaged in seining operations shall hold a commercial fishing license.
4. No fish taken shall be transported to, planted, or held in any other natural or impounded waters.
5. When no market for carp exists, excess carp shall be buried or otherwise disposed of, under the direction of the warden in charge.
6. Permittee shall avoid, so far as possible, netting in areas where black bass are spawning.
7. The permittee voluntarily agreed to carry on such rescue work, at such times, and in such places as is deemed necessary by the warden in charge.

8. This permit is in effect from April 23 to April 27, 1951, inclusive and may be terminated, revoked or modified by the Fish and Game Commission at any time for any violation of the terms hereof, or for any other good cause.
