EAST PARK RESERVOIR, Colusa County

April 6, 1954

1. Don Kelley, Fraser and Leonard Fiske at reservoir at 6:15 a.m. to meet Grasteit and crew for test seining but they did not show up.
2. Shore temperature 57° - 9:45 a.m.
3. Water level at maximum. Spilling over dam. Heavy inflow from Stony Creek - very muddy.
4. Concession operator says bass, BG, fish good. Some crappie caught up to 9" in length. Bass up to 6 lbs. Carp abundant. BG up to 9". Rarely a trout is caught. One caught last summer - 2½ lbs.
5. Fairly good looking reservoir, many bays and shoal areas.
6. Concession has 27 boats and there are four rental boats on southeast arm.
7. Warden Grinnell reports catfish being caught in East Park up to 6 lbs. in weight.
8. Fishing pressure is in the neighborhood of 100 or more boat days a week in the summer.
