SUBJECT: Chemical treatment of East Park Reservoir.

I made a trip into East Park Reservoir Sunday 20 Sept. to check the results of the treatment and spent about 1/2 hour looking for some sign of life and did not see a live fish. There appears to be tons of Carp and some Catfish and an enormous number of stunted Crappie and Blue gill floating on the surface.

I would say from my observations that a 100% Kill resulted from the treatment.
