Notice of Proposed Withdrawal and Reservation of Lands

APRIL 16, 1964.

The Bureau of Reclamation, U.S. Department of the Interior has filed an application, Serial Number Sacramento 078407, for the withdrawal of the lands described below, from all forms of appropriation under the public land laws, including the mining but not the mineral leasing laws, subject to valid existing claims. The applicant desires the land for the Orland Project for operation and maintenance and other management requirements in close proximity to East Park Reservoir, California.

For a period of 30 days from the date of publication of this notice, all persons who wish to submit comments, suggestion, or objections in connection with the proposed withdrawal may present their views in writing to the undersigned officer of the Bureau of Land Management, Department of the Interior, Room 4201, U.S. Courthouse and Federal Building, 650 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California.

If circumstances warrant it, a public hearing will be held at a convenient time and place, which will be announced.

The determination of the Secretary on the application will be published in the FEDERAL REGISTER. A separate notice will be sent to each interested party of record.
