Subject: East Park Reservoir Planting Program**Plant the following:**

LMB - 60,000 fry or fingerlings. Preferred race is the LMB-Florida. If enough of these are not available, plant northern fry or fingerlings. Stocking the bass is a high priority project. They should be scattered around the edge of the lake at all feasible access points. The objective is to avoid stunting and have the bass reach ten inches in one year.

Channel Catfish - Of the estimated 60,000 1972 fingerlings on hand, set aside 20,000 for October plants. All the remaining plant in East Park at earliest opportunity (February-March).

In addition should 1973 fingerlings become available from Region 5 this May, plant enough to bring total in East Park up to 50,000.

Redear Sunfish - Plant 1,000 adults prior to May 1.

Crappie - Plant 100 black and 100 white crappie adults prior to April 1.

Threadfin Shad - Plant 10,000 adults prior to May 1.
