I think three major factors were responsible  
East Park today,

for poor success at ~~this reservoir on this day~~

First, the windy conditions present from 1130 to  
1400 hours resulted in white capped water.

Secondly, it was reported to ~~this checker~~<sup>me</sup>  
that threadfin shad spawning activity had been  
noticed lately. This would provide a food  
source for both crappie and large mouth bass.

Finally, the unavailability of proper bait  
was a factor in poor angling success. The only

baits available were artificial lures and anchovies.

A desirability to trap and sell threadfin shad from the reservoir was expressed by the concessioner. He was advised to contact the area associate biologist.
