Thank you for your recent letter about East Park Reservoir. This reservoir was dry in the drought year 1977. In 1978 and 1979 the lake was restocked with seed stock of largemouth bass, redear sunfish and channel catfish. We have no current information on the status of these fish, but we will check on this in the next month or so. If additional fish are needed to utilize the available habitat, more will be planted.
