In June 1980 I met with a Mr. Paul Barney, Resource Manager, employed by the Bureau of Reclamation (Water and Power Resources Service) and headquartered at Stony Gorge Reservoir. Barney has an office (phone 968-5235) and corporation yard at this location. A large crew of YACC and other personnel assist him. He works under the supervision of Jerry Fidler at the Water and Power Resources Service Willows office.

Barney is charged with the development and operation of the public recreation program at subject reservoirs. He is very interested in fish habitat improvement work and has the personnel and equipment to carry it out. He stated he can direct time to this activity in the fall-winter period. Purchase of material should be initiated this summer. He has a supply of 20' x 20' eight inch stainless steel cargo nets that may be useful in any brush shelter project. He is aware of the grass seeding work at Oroville and may want to try it at his waters.

John } Plan to have the new Marysville District Biologist develop a long range habitat improvement program at subject waters with the WPRS. Work directly with Barney. Our role is essentially one of technical advisor. In addition, keep Barney supplied with any reports, field data on the fisheries that we or IFB have or may develop in the future. His personnel may be available for creel check or other fisheries survey activities.
