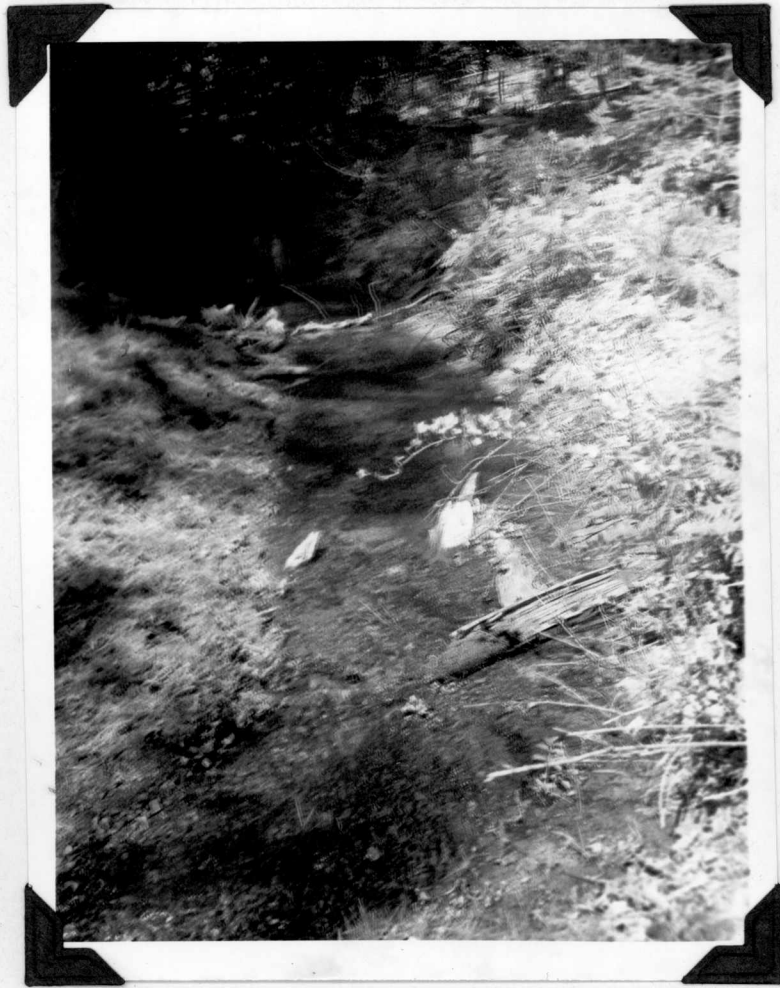

"Letts Creek is a small spring fed tributary to South Fork Stony Creek. It rises in two meadows known as upper and lower Letts Valleys. When visited on the 9th of August the lower meadow was producing no flow in the channel below. About 20 GPM was flowing off the upper meadow. This water comes from springs around the perimeter of the meadow, meanders through the meadow and finally collects at the lower end. The stream was followed about 500 yds. but no fish were seen. Informants say there are some fish in the lower one-half mile of the stream, but that few people fish there. No planting recommended."
