Letts Lake, Colusa County

On Monday, October 30, 1967, Dusty Rhoads, Colusa County Road Commissioner, phoned that he completed about \$1,700 worth of bog removal at Letts Lake. We plan to chemically treat the lake October 31 and detoxify the rotenone with P. Permanganate in the week of November 6 - 10. A total of 5,000 RT subs will be stocked in December after the lake partially refills.

Rhoads said that if in the future we wish to remove the remaining large bog he believes it could be done for about \$2,000 with no problems provided it was anchored at the upper end of the lake. There is a good hard bottom near the campground.
