

Subject: Letts Lake, Colusa County

On May 25, 1975, Memorial Day weekend, I creel checked Letts Lake. Some 26 shore anglers fished 49.5 hours (incomplete effort) and caught 14 hatchery rainbow trout, each about 10 inches long. Catch per angler hour was 0.28. All parties had at least one fish. Boat anglers were not checked. Three anglers were from Mendocino County. All others were from Bay Area counties.

Present management of this lake is apparently satisfactory.
