Subject: Debris Cleanup, Lower Letts Lake, Colusa County

On January 15, 1968, I had a phone conversation with District Ranger Don Vaughn at Stonyford regarding the cleanup work that is necessary at Lower Letts Lake before the special Use Permit can be cancelled. The special Use Permit covered a proposed dam that was abandoned due to unstable soil conditions.

On December 22, 1967, Mr. Montgomery wrote a letter to Mr. Harvey Lewis, Camp Superintendent of the Fouts Spring Boys Camp at Stonyford, asking whether a group of boys from the camp could assist with the cleanup.

Mr. Vaughn informed me that he had talked with Mr. Lewis regarding the cleanup work. Mr. Lewis will take some boys up and do the work this winter and spring. The Forest Service will furnish the tools. When this work is accomplished, the special Use Permit will be cancelled.
