Subject: Letts Lake, Colusa County	

I was up at Letts Lake on Aug. 13 - 18 on my annual deer hunt and make the following observations:

Crayfish are still plentiful - my kids caught plenty.

The lake is higher than in the last 15 years and RT-c are still being caught near the dam in small numbers; no RT concentrated near the springs flowing in.

Golden shiners are not visible.

3 - 6 " largemouth are abundant along the shore.

About 20 largemouth of 9 - 11" were taken by anglers; I saw nine cleaned; stomachs contained crayfish only.

Several 7 - 9" channel catfish were reported taken.

Campgrounds full - half hunters, half campers as opposed to years ago when almost all hunters.

Looks like oversummer survival of RT will occur.

P.S. No bucks for me.
