

Letts Lake, Colusa County

Please include in your next news release the following information.

Letts Lake, a small trout lake 20 miles west of Stonyford, Colusa County, will be drained shortly after Labor Day to permit the chemical treatment of the rough fish present and the removal of several small floating bogs. The rough fish were introduced illegally by bait fishermen and have made the lake unsuitable for trout. The small bogs pose a threat to the lake in that they could block the spillway.

The lake will refill this winter and good trout fishing is expected to develop next May from our stocking program.
