
I would like to extend the thanks of the Department of Fish and Game for the fine support which the Colusa County Board of Supervisors gave us in the treatment of Letts Valley Reservoir. Your cooperation in furnishing funds for the chemical treatment and detoxification of the reservoir is sincerely appreciated not only by us, but by the many sportsmen who will be enjoying the much improved fishing in the reservoir in the future.

To our knowledge, the treatment was a complete success and we have planted 5,000 rainbow trout fingerlings and will plant 5,000 more in the fall. As of the 18th of June we had planted 3,600 catchables. I believe there has been another direct plant since the 18th, but I don't have the records on that as yet since the cards have not come down from Darrah Springs Hatchery.

In all, there will be 5,000 catchables planted during the 1965 recreational season which should furnish good fishing throughout the summer months.
