Letts Valley Reservoir, Coluss County

We are endeavoring to draw up fisheries management plans for Region II waters for 1960. In considering what should be done at Letts Valley Reservoir, we are handicapped by lack of information. We have your note of May 12, 1959, indicating that cold weather prevailed at the opening of the fishing season, and fishing success was limited. On June 25, you informed us that surface water temperatures in the reservoir were extremely high and considerable mortality had occurred during the planting of fingerlings.

It would be appreciated if you could supply us with any pertinent information which you may have obtained during the souths of July and August relating to water temperatures and the quality of fishing.
