Comments: Under the supervision of a Senior Environmental Scientist (Supervisory), the incumbent will provide technical field and office support for the Instream Flow Program and Cannabis Program flow efforts. The position involves use of a variety of specialized meters, surveying equipment, and water measurement tools, which require a high level of attention to detail and accuracy while adhering to standard operating procedures. The incumbent will collect, organize, and manage complex data; prepare field sampling documentation and maps; and organize, inventory, and order office supplies and field equipment. The incumbent will also perform various tasks on computer systems including spreadsheets, emails, databases, and word processing functions (e.g., data entry, data management, literature searches). Experience with data quality assurance/quality control practices (e.g., data verification and validation) is essential to perform duties.

The incumbent is expected to maintain a valid driver's license and be able to safely operate large four-wheel drive vehicles.

Working conditions may require the incumbent to stay in hotels statewide for up to four nights a week on overnight travel. Travel can occur up to three weeks in any given month. The incumbent must be able to carry 30 lbs. for up to 8 miles, be comfortable working in inclement weather, swift water, and uneven and slippery stream habitats where work is located.

The incumbent must be able to work closely with internal and external staff in a team environment.

Comments: Under the supervision of the Senior Environmental Scientist (Supervisor), the position involves all aspects of wildlife area operation and maintenance, including habitat management and planting, noxious weed control, building, and equipment maintenance and repair, and operation of a hunter check station. The position involves using a variety of specialized tools, meters, pumps, vehicles, and heavy equipment to perform the duties. Must be able to lift 40 lbs. and be able to work in all types of weather conditions; work in, around water, and on uneven ground. Work schedule is typically 7:00 am – 3:30 pm, but will vary.
