Assist in the operation of a high country remote spawning operation, as well as the sorting and spawning of off-site domestic Brood fish. Collection of water samples and data required for National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System compliance.

Incumbent to perform maintenance of vehicles, grounds, facility equipment, and must possess a willingness to do manual labor in all weather conditions.
