Under the direction of the Special Operations, Wildlife Trafficking Unit Captain, incumbent performs complex internet investigations pertaining to the illegal trafficking of wildlife. Applicant will monitor online sale sites for the presence of possible illegal posts concerning the offering for sale, offering to purchase or bartering of restricted or prohibited wildlife species. Applicant will investigate the importation, exportation, buying and selling, transportation and possession of illegal fish and wildlife. Applicant will work closely with the US Fish and Wildlife Service on wildlife trafficking cases and deconflict all investigations with allied agencies as appropriate. Applicant will be expected to conduct complex investigations and secure/serve search warrants specializing in electronic devices. Applicant will assist with the inspection of airports, docks, postal inspections and other means of transport for illegal fish and wildlife; investigates businesses and fish markets for wildlife trafficking violations.
