SUBJECT: Weed poisoning in Letts Lake area.

I call the Colusa County Agriculture Department this morning and asked about this project. The response from Mr. Disney (Agriculture Commissioner) was that his office was co-operating with the U.S. Forest Service with plans to poison weeds in Letts Lake and Lower Letts Lake (known also as Lily Pond).

The plans are essentially as follows:

- 1). The weeds to be poisoned are primarily tule.
- 2). The poison to be used is 24D.
- 3). Most of the poisoning will be done in the proposed Lower Letts Lake reservoir site. Some poisoning is contemplated in Letts Lake.
- 4). The work is not planned to start until about May or more likely June 1963.
- 5). The local warden (Dick Laursen) will be notified prior to the start of actual work so that I can inform my Department.

Mr. Disney stated that he would be happy to have any technical information pertaining to the project that would assist him in doing more efficient work.
