Request for permission to trap and sell minnows.

We have received the enclosed application. In the main it is a request for permission to trap minnows from Stoney Creek above East Park Reservoir and permission to sell these minnows for bait. I believe the above are handled by the central office. There is also the matter of a small holding tank 15 x 3 ft. which might be of concern to you. However this will drain into the same water from which the minnows are taken so will not offer any biological problem. We plan to do some work in this area this spring and can look into it further at that time if you think there is a need.

We are sending this via Garth Murphy so that he may add any comments as to its possible affect on his program in East Park Res. the coming year.
