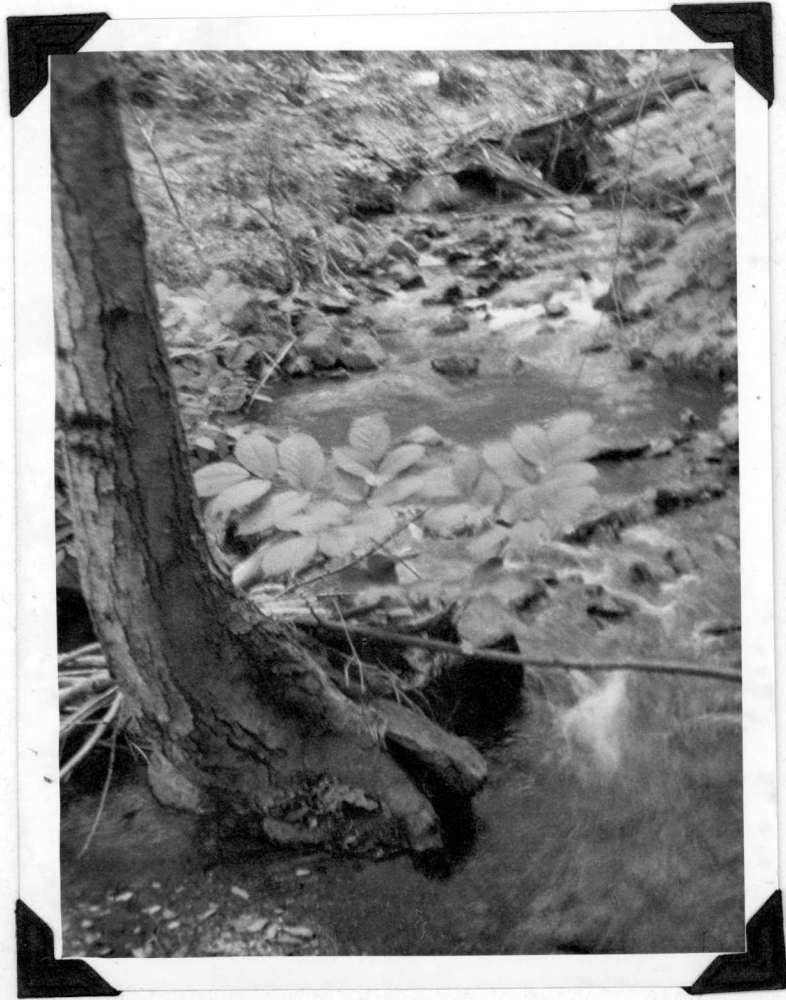
SOURCES OF DATA

"This is a small tributary to Middle Fork Stony Creek. It was examined at Happy Camp at 5:00 PM on August 9. It has a flow of 3 CFS. The water was 59 and the air 73 degrees F. There seems to be a good population of 4-7 inch RT, and fry appear to be common though observation is difficult due to heavy shading. The Author fished for 1.25 hours in the stream above Happy Camp and caught 15 trout ranging from 4 to 7 inches. From informants the fishing effort is light above, Happy Camp and medium below.

Some stocking below Happy Camp might benefit the fishing, especially if the fishing intensity increases much."
