Here are two copies of the Stony Creek Watershed map you requested at the December 4 saddle session. Capacities of the reservoirs were estimated as follows:

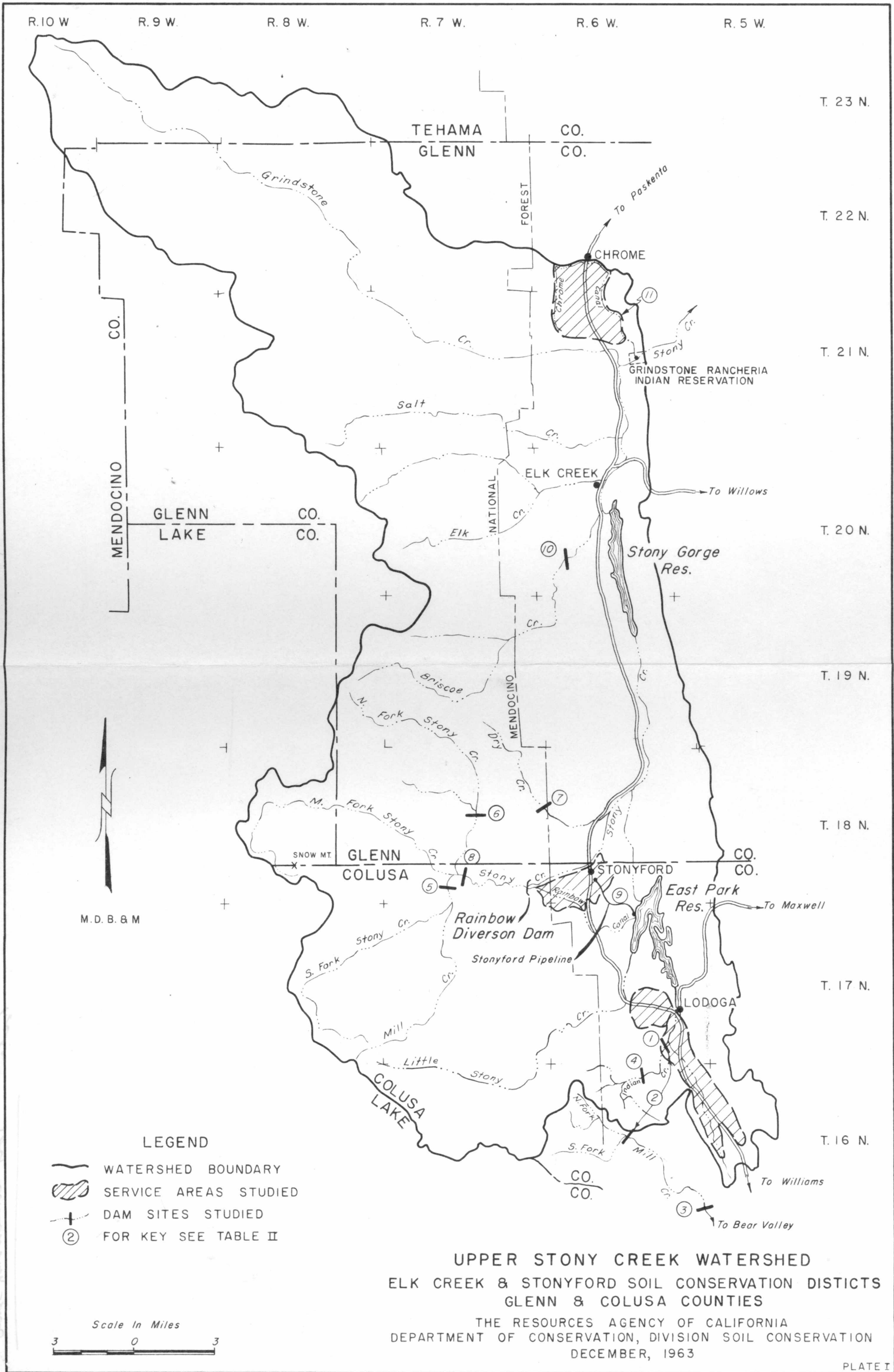
1. Lower Indian	3,740	AF

7. Dry Creek	6,230	AF
8. Red Bridge	10,000	AF
10. Briscoe Rocks	13,600	AF

*maybe 200 ac. at 50' depth*
