As you have plenty of trout for planting, why don't you plant a full truck load at Red Bridge in Big Stony Creek in Colusa County now. Then they would scatter up and down the Creek before the season opens on April 30, and more anglers would catch them. If you plant two or three days before the season opens the first dozen families catch them all out in two days.

I can't go fishing, but plant at once, and then again on April 26 if you wish.
