Subject: Bureau of Reclamation River Flow Meeting September 30, 1982

See attached.

In regard to Glenn-Colusa fish screen no by-pass problem in August-September 1982, Bureau of Reclamation reports flow of about 6,000 at Hamilton City during that period. Base flow is 5,000. If we have another wet year, we can expect low flows again in August 1983. In a wet year they don't release out of Shasta for Delta salinity control.

On February 1, we will check with Bureau of Reclamation at this time they make their first estimate; wet or dry. If wet, we push harder on GCID to dredge their channel.

FWS will be conducting an evaluation of their large drum screen at the T.C. Fish Facilities in April-June 1983 using large nets, etc. We should observe this.

Bureau of Reclamation will have funds in 1983 and 1984 to make major repairs or rebuild the Nimbus fish rack. They will review plans with us.
