Subject: Glenn-Colusa Fish Screen

I talked with Bob Clark of Glenn-Colusa I.D. in regard to bypass water at subject screen during the 1983 irrigation season on 1-24-83. Bob said the B of R plans about the same river flow in '83 and in '82. To avoid the problem of no bypass water in the August period, he plans to dredge as needed in the upper end of the channel. Last year he claims the B of R changed their operation without notice which resulted in the reduced flow to his pumps. It was then too late to move his equipment.

In addition, he plans to make maximum use of water diverted at Red Bluff to reduce pumping at his plant. Also, he anticipates about a 25% reduction in demand due to decreased rice acreage.

These factors suggest we may not have a bypass problem this summer.
