Dear Mr. Andrews;

Glenn-Colusa Irrigation District is presently studying the Sacramento River Channel trajectory and comparing same to past years. I have information that your aerial reconnaissance of the Sacramento River, dated May 27, 1975, covers the area northeast of our Main Pumping Plant above Hamilton City.

The District is presently involved in a controversy with the State Department of Fish & Game regarding operation of their fishscreens on our Pumping Plant forebay. Neither the District nor Fish & Game can obtain adequate flow for standard operations compared to prior years. In an effort to mitigate this problem we are involved in a hydraulic analysis of the District's intake channel and the aspect of the Sacramento River at the mouth of this channel. This study includes charting the position of the west bank of the Sacramento River at this location and we are therefore requesting your permission to utilize Exp #S.R.5-6 and #S.R.5-7 flown by CH2M/Hill aerial surveys on May 27, 1975.
