Upper Sacramento River Salmon
And Steelhead Advisory Committee

The third meeting of the 1986 Advisory Committee began at 10 a.m., February 1, 1986 in the Region 1 conference room in Redding. All members were present except Messrs. Moss, Dodgin and Ferris.

Chairman Frost opened the meeting and asked Dr. Warden if the draft GCID report was ready. Copies were then distributed. Several slides of the screen and pumps were shown and discussed. A brief discussion of the report followed and the Committee took time to read the draft report.


Mr. Maloney then mentioned the discussion he had recently with Pat O'Brien of Region 2 regarding billing. He indicated the District had paid the Department and that an agreement had been worked out on standby time for the screen. He then pointed out that the District is exploring the possibility of moving the diversion to some upstream point. That was followed by a discussion of the ramifications of doing that.

The Committee then discussed the report and how strong the recommendations should be. After considerable discussion, a three-point approach was endorsed. First: all interim corrections should be implemented, Second: a conceptual design should be developed within a year, and Third: that if the conceptual design is not completed at the end of the year, legal recourse should be pursued. The need for the Committee to hear from District Manager Bob Clark was discussed and the chairman will contact him to arrange a meeting date.

After lunch, the Committee went through a thorough review of the report up to the Findings. This included a discussion of the need for graphics.

Chairman Frost said he would arrange a meeting date with Mr. Clark and it will be announced in the minutes. The next meeting will be February 22 in the Region 1 conference room.

Before the meeting adjourned several items of written material were distributed. Others were to be reproduced and sent with the minutes. An up-to-date list of members is attached to reflect an address change for Mr. DeJournette.
