I contacted Mr. Michael Harvey of Colorado State University concerning the costs for assisting GCID and the California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG) in the preparation of a request for proposal (RFP) for a study of a mechanics and morphology of the Sacramento River in the vicinity of the GCID diversion channel.

We propose to pick up Mr. Harvey in our aircraft at the Santa Rosa airport at noon, October 9, 1986, and fly him to Willows. Neal and Mike will field review the reach of river between Hamilton City and Woodson Bridge by air and by ground on October 9th. On October 10th they will prepare an outline of the RFP and commence the preparation of a preliminary draft. We would like to do this work in your office. The preliminary draft will be sent to you and GCID for review by October 15th.

This schedule will allow you a few days for review prior to our joint meeting in Sacramento on October 21st.
