GRIMES SALMON SEASON CATCH: 13,923 POUNDS

The first annual count of the Grimes Boat Club reveals a record salmon catch in the Sacramento River at Grimes of 870 fish weighing an aggregate 13,923 pounds during the August 1st to November 1st season.

Deputy Sheriff M. C. Brown, chairman of the club's advertising committee, won a \$50 grand prize for pulling in the largest fish with a 34-1/4 pounder he caught in mid-October.

Weekly prizes of \$5 apiece went to Brown and others catching the largest fish during each week of the season.

Brown estimates an additional four to five thousand pounds of salmon escaped the overall count, made at weighing stations at Hollenbeck's Landing, the Rathbun Store and the Green Tree Cafe.

The counts for each scale are Hollenbeck's, 729 fish weighing 11,014 pounds; the cafe, 109 fish scaling 2,428 pounds, and the store, 32 fish tipping the scales at 481 pounds.
