SUBJECT: Information from Maloney Regarding Steelhead

Larry Maloney, Tom Maloney's son, caught two 10-inch rainbows and three 16 and 19 inch marked (fin clipped) steelheads on the Princeton riffle on January 1 or 2, 1954. Tom was informed me that during the summer months striped bass cut open by himself and other sportsmen contained salmonoid and pike in their stomachs. He feels that stripers are definitely detrimental to salmonoid reproduction in the upper Sacramento River.
