Subject : Water Rights Appropriation Application #29335

We have received and reviewed Water Rights Appropriation Application #29335 to divert 3.2 acre-feet per annum from Trout Creek in Colusa County, between the dates of December 1 and March 31 of the succeeding year. Mr. Fred Meyer of my staff inspected the site on June 11, 1993, and determined that the proposed additional diversion would not create any significant impacts over those that exist under the present diversion right as per the state H.C. Angle Decree.

The applicant should be advised that work within the 100-year flood plain, consisting of, but not limited to diversion or obstruction of the natural flow or changes in the channel, bed, or bank of any river, stream, or lake, will require notification to the DFG as required by Fish and Game Code Section 1600 et seq. (application enclosed). The notification (with fee), and subsequent agreement, must be completed prior to initiating any such work. Notification to the DFG should be made after the project is approved by the lead agency. The agreement process should not be used in lieu of specific mitigation measures to be included as conditions of project approval by the lead agency.
