> That's a lot of petroleum.

It's easy to protect the marine ecosystem and still have fun!

Follow these tips to prevent spilling oil into California's waterways:

Hold the fuel dispenser upright, so it doesn't drip onto the dock, your boat, or into the water.

> Use an absorbent cloth to wipe up any drips or spills.

> > Never use detergent to disperse spilled oil. Detergent pushes oil into the water column and adds another toxin to the ecosystem.
